DISTRIBUTION *We are communing by gathering around the altar. As the Spirit prompts you, find an empty space at the altar. Receive the bread and dip it in the cup. When you are ready, return to your seat. Gluten free wafers are available.*

BLESSING *After all have communed, the congregation receives a blessing.*

PRAYER *We give thanks for God's presence and ask for God to send us as witnesses into the world.*

SENDING
