

Greeters

Arrive 15 minutes before the start of service (7:45am or 10:15am).

Introduce yourself to anyone you don't know. This way you get to meet some new people, too. Find out if they are a visitor. Ask them how often they have been to visit. If they have been several times, ask them if they need any help finding anything.

If they are first time visitors:

- Point out the locations of the coat racks, restrooms.
- Please ask them to sign the visitor book located by the door (ask for an email).
- While they hang up their coat, wait for them.
- Talk some more with them and escort them to an usher.
- The usher will make sure that they are taken care of during the service.

After the service, go find any visitor that you met earlier, even if they are repeat visitors. If there is more than one, get the other greeter or even other members to help you:

- Go back to the visitor.
- Ask them to come and join you for a cup of coffee.
- Ask them if they would like to meet the Pastor.
- Introduce them to some other members.

Please note:

As a second service greeter, keep your eye on those coming out of Sunday School to make sure any visitors who attended are also being cared for.

If they have small children, explain the "Prayground" area up front.
